As part of our 'What Was New About the New Stone Age?' topic, Year 3 will be going on a trip to The Chiltern Open Air Museum in Chalfont-St-Giles. Date: **Monday, 1 July 2019**

Lunch: All children will require a packed lunch on this day preferably in a carrier bag so it can be thrown away. Please ensure your child has plenty to drink, however, no fizzy drinks are allowed.
