Dear Parents,

We have arranged for Year 6 to visit Hazard Alley in Milton Keynes on Thursday, 27 June. Hazard Alley is a safety centre run by Bucks CC which provides a series of scenarios through which children enhance their knowledge of keeping safe. We will leave school at 9.15 am and be back by 3.15 pm.

To cover the cost of the visit we must request a contribution of £16.50 per child for entrance and the coach fare. If we do not receive enough money to cover the cost of the trip it will have to be cancelled.

All children will need to bring a packed lunch in a plastic bag that can be thrown away, and a drink in an unbreakable container. If your child is entitled to a free school packed lunch, please indicate below if you would like ham or cheese.

We would advise that girls wear trousers for the visit as children will be putting each other into the recovery position.

Children may also bring some spending money to buy a small souvenir from Hazard Alley. We suggest £2.00 maximum. Children will be responsible for their own money.
